The First Step Program provides material assistance (bushels, boxes, robes and other fully essential) and case management services to low income pregnant women and families with children ages 0-5.

of our budget is dedicated to services for older adults, such as Senior Support (Columbiana, Mahoning and Trumbull Counties), Guardianship (Ashland County), Adult Day Services (Stark County), and the Senior-CareHome-Cultured Meals Program (Garfieldwood).

of our budget is dedicated to social, educational, and other local supportive services, including:
