





Our Mission:

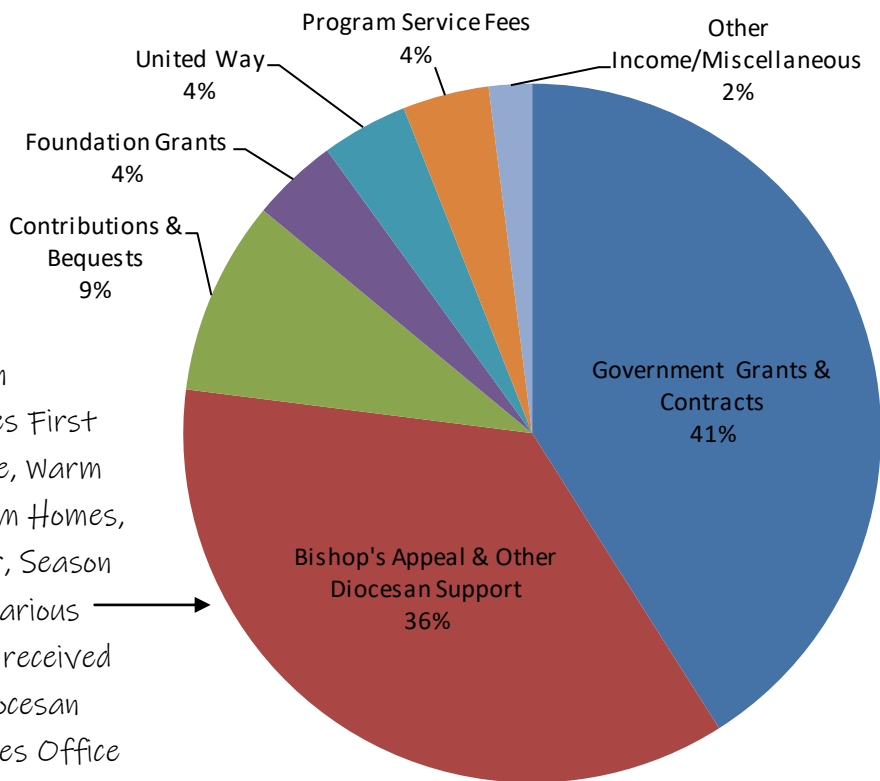
