In 2020 ...

- 361 utility payments were made for families in need, totaling over \$73,000 in assistance.
- 489 rent payments were made for families in need, totaling over \$300,000.
- 956 people received emergency financial assistance with food, clothing, and other basic needs unrelated to utilities and rent, totaling \$160,000.
- 261 people received homeless outreach and prevention services.
- 553 people were assisted with obtaining access to safe, affordable housing.
- 835 people were assisted with access to nutritious food.
- 286 people received financial literacy education.
- 1,042 students participated in a school-based risk avoidance curriculum facilitated by agency staff.
- 68 households received diapers, formula and other baby needs through the agency's First Step program.
- 12 households participated in Project Assisi, a program designed to provide enhanced financial assistance and case management for families on the edge of poverty.
