- 735 people received food vouchers and emergency food assistance.
- 888 people received homeless outreach and rapid rehousing services.
- 338 pregnant women and families with young children received material assistance and/or case management services through the First Step program.
- 506 people received senior support services, including transportation, telephone reassurance, friendly visitation and in-home case management.
- 507 people received housing counseling and related homeless prevention assistance to help them stay in their homes and avoid homelessness, as well as 181 received financial literacy counseling to help them develop a realistic household budget.
- 2046 people received utility assistance through Keep the Kids Warm and other funds.
- 187 returning citizens received prison re-entry services for housing and linkages with other community services and resources.
- 35 women and children received 820 nights of shelter at Christina House, the county's domestic violence shelter sponsored by Catholic Charities Regional Agency.
- 187 people were assisted with obtaining a protection order, as well as 402 individuals assisted with legal advocacy.
- 499 older adults received 16,034 on-site and home-delivered hot meals through Catholic Charities Regional Agency's Senior Center in East Liverpool.
