Please make sure to note "Afghan Crisis" or "General Donation" in the memo line of your check. Gift cards to local department stores, grocery stores and restaurants can help people with basic needs, such as food, clothing, health and hygiene products, and other essential items. Gift cards can be mailed to the address above.
