Our faith reminds us of our call to respect, protect and uphold the dignity of every single person, at every single stage in his or her life. By supporting First Step for Change throughout the school year, you will be helping Catholic Charities give a happy, healthy start to those in their earliest stages of life.

**How does it work?** We are asking classrooms to offer students an optional CHARITY dress down day once during each season below. - Dress down day #1 October (Respect Life Month)
  Theme idea: wear purple for Domestic Violence Awareness

  - **Theme idea**: wear hats & gloves to class, and donate them to the poor at the end of the day.
- Dress down day #3 March (Care for Creation)
  - **Theme idea**: as a class, plant a window box & watch it grow throughout the Spring.
