#### Here's what you need to know:

- All hygiene items should be placed in a gallon-sized Ziploc bag (or larger). (Please note: the Ziploc bags are not provided.)
- Completed kits should be returned to your classroom for collection.
- Return Deadline We request completed kits be delivered to Catholic Charities by November 5, 2025. Call or email to discuss pick-up arrangements if needed.

### **HYGIENE KIT SHOPPING LIST**

Each hygiene kit should include the following items, packed/sealed in a one-gallon size Ziploc bag:

- Travel-size shampoo and conditioner
- Travel-size body wash or (1) individually wrapped bar of soap
  - Deodorant/Antiperspirant
  - Comb or small brush
  - Disposable razor
  - Pack of tissues
  - Hand sanitizer (travel-size)
- Hand lotion/moisturizer
  - Feminine hygiene products (pads or tampons)
- ☐ Nail clippers/nail kit
- ☐ Lip balm/Chapstick

The contents of each hygiene kit may have a retail value of approximately \$20-\$25—but to someone in crisis, the dignity, comfort, and care it provides is truly immeasurable.
