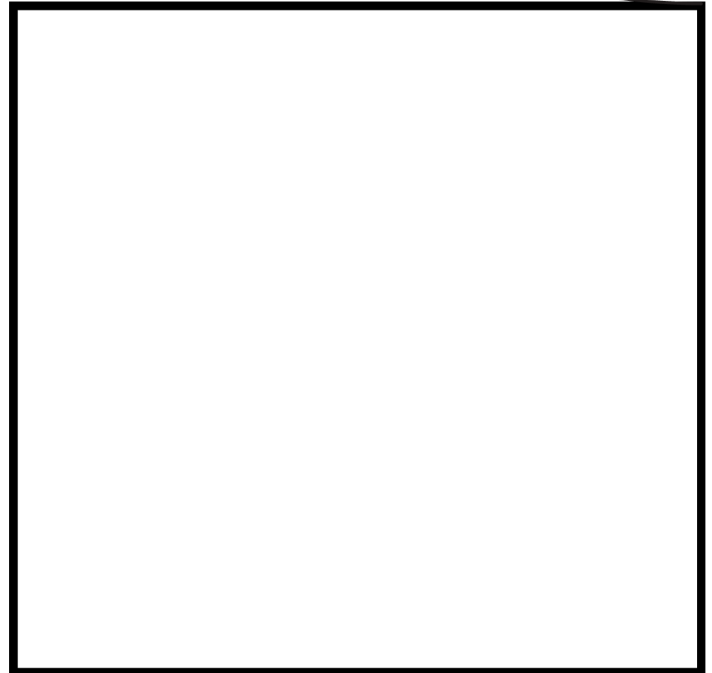


LEARN

Close your eyes and listen carefully to the story about **A Little Free Garden**. Try to imagine Leah's garden, the vegetables, and the flowers. Also try to see the children walking home with weekend lunch bags. What do you think is in those bags? See the neighbors taking vegetables from the garden home with them. Think about how everyone in the story might be feeling.

When the story is finished, open your eyes and draw a picture of the one thing that stuck in your mind the most about this story.



DISCUSS

Observation: How did Leah notice that some children didn't have enough food?

Action: What did Leah do to help others in her community?

Reflection: What does the verse "love not in word or speech but in deed and truth" mean to you?

Empathy: How do you think the children and neighbors felt when they took food from Leah's garden?

Application: Can you think of a way you could help someone in your school, home, or neighborhood this week?
